Students receiving financial aid are expected to complete degree or certificate programs within an allowable number of attempted credits, in accordance with the <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy</u>. If unusual circumstances prevented you from completing your program within the maximum attempted credit limit, you may appeal for an extension of your financial aid eligibility.

Allow 2-3 weeks for review of your appeal; you will be notified via your WWU email if additional information is required or when a decision has been reached. Students are responsible for all account related charges due while appeals are being processed and in the event the appeal is denied. If your appeal is approved, financial aid is limited to only the coursework listed on the Official Degree Evaluation. Additional coursework will not change your financial aid eligibility and deviating from your plan may nullify an approved appeal.

Due dates:

Complete appeals must be submitted before the **Quarterly Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)** deadlines. Appeals submitted after the deadline are not eligible for reinstatement for the current quarter. The deadlines for appeals for the 2024-2025 academic year are as follows:

Fall 2024:	Friday November 8, 2024
Winter 2025:	Friday February 21, 2025
Spring 2025:	Friday May 16, 2025
Summer 2025:	Friday July 18, 2025

Your appeal must include the following:

- A **typed explanation** of the unusual circumstances that prevented you from completing your degree or certificate within the maximum allowable credit limit
- Submit the following documents to the Registrar's Office, depending on your student status:
 - Undergraduate and post-baccalaureate degree-seeking students:
 - ✓ Apply for graduation by completing the <u>Degree Application (PDF)</u> found on the <u>Registrar's Office website</u>, under Bachelor's Degree Information.
 - ✓ Submit a Degree Application and major/minor evaluations (if applicable) to the Registrar's Office and inform them your request is being made for financial aid purposes by checking the indicated box.
 - ✓ If you are an undergraduate seeking additional teaching endorsements outside the parameters for your degree, include the appropriate departmental endorsement evaluation in your appeal. Do not submit departmental teaching endorsement evaluations to the Registrar's Office.
 - **Post-baccalaureate certificate-seeking students** in Teacher Certification programs:
 - \checkmark Request the evaluation from your department.
 - Graduate students:
 - ✓ Submit documentation from the Graduate Office verifying your anticipated program completion date, outstanding requirements, and satisfactory academic progress.

To submit your appeal:

Attach your **typed appeal** and all required documentation to this form and bring it to Old Main 265, send it to the financial aid department using your **WWU student email**, or submit it with the <u>Secure Document Uploader</u>. Appeals missing the Official Degree Evaluation will be considered incomplete.
